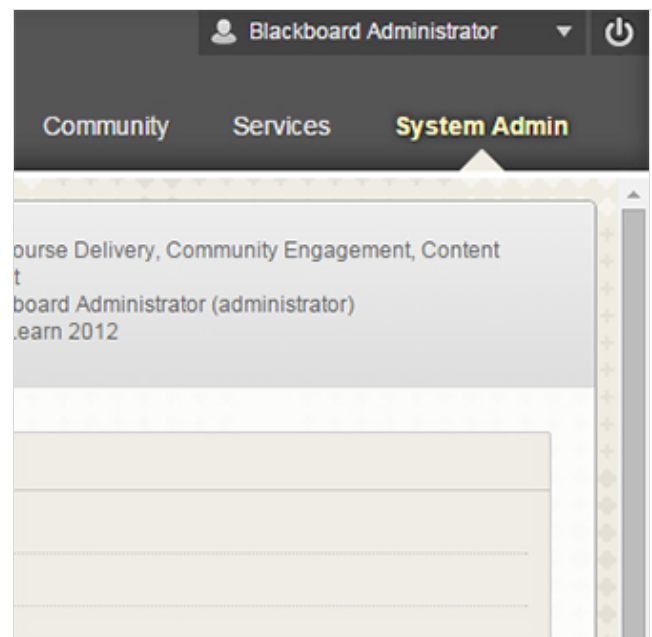
You can embed videos into your lesson plan with one click and use the fully featured ClickView Web Player to share educational videos with your students.

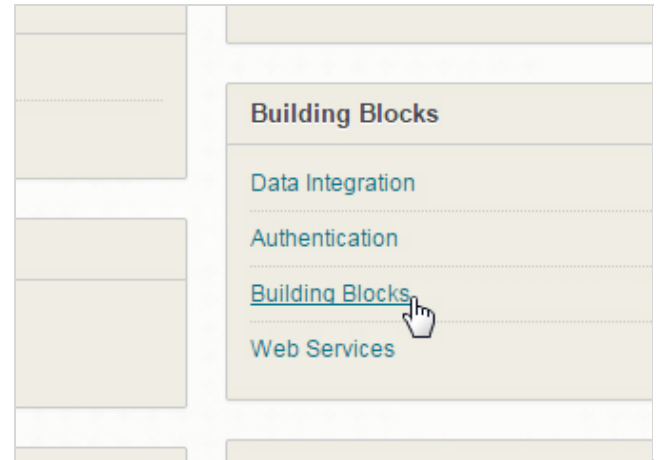

Log in with an administrative account and then click on the 'System Admin' tab in the top right-hand corner of the screen.



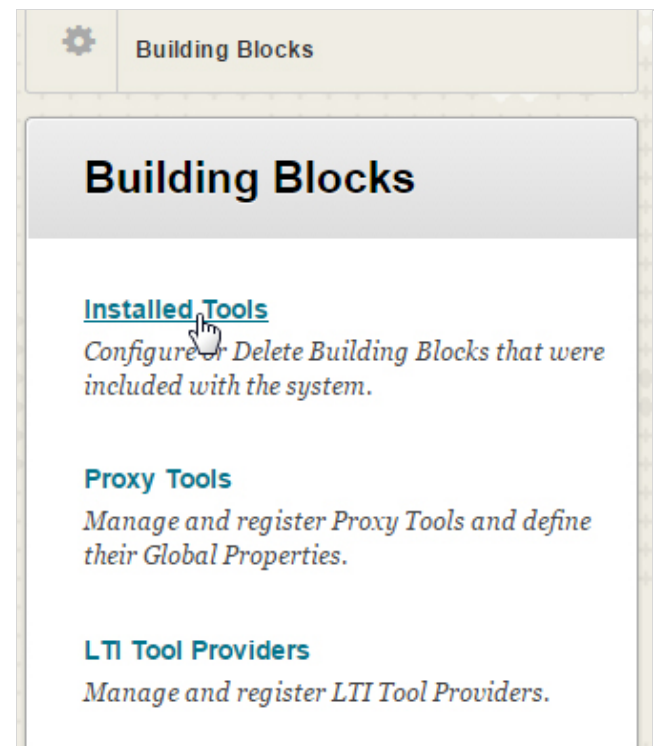

Find and access 'Building Blocks' within the Administrator Panel.



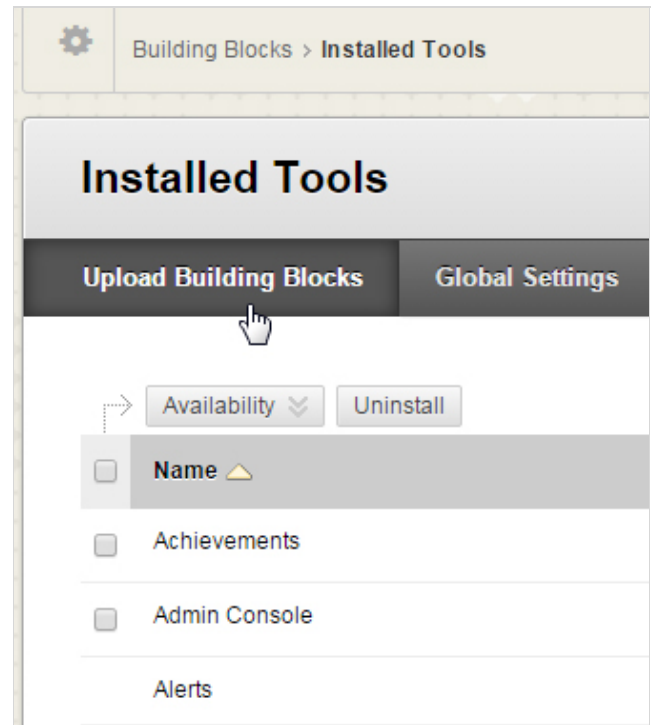

Select 'Installed Tools'.

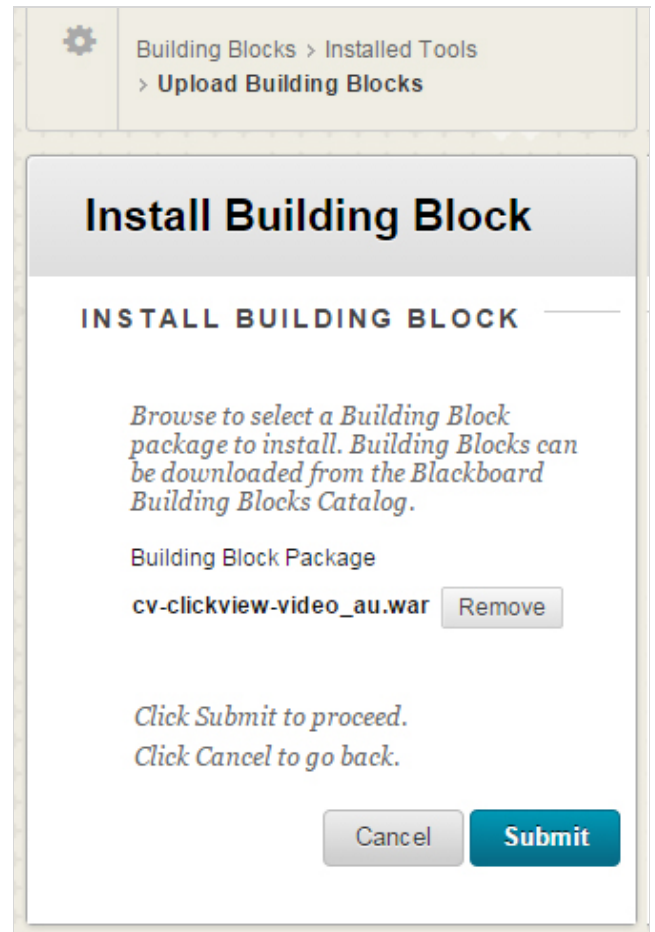
Click on 'Upload Building Blocks'.

Browse to the downloaded plugin and click on the 'Submit' button.

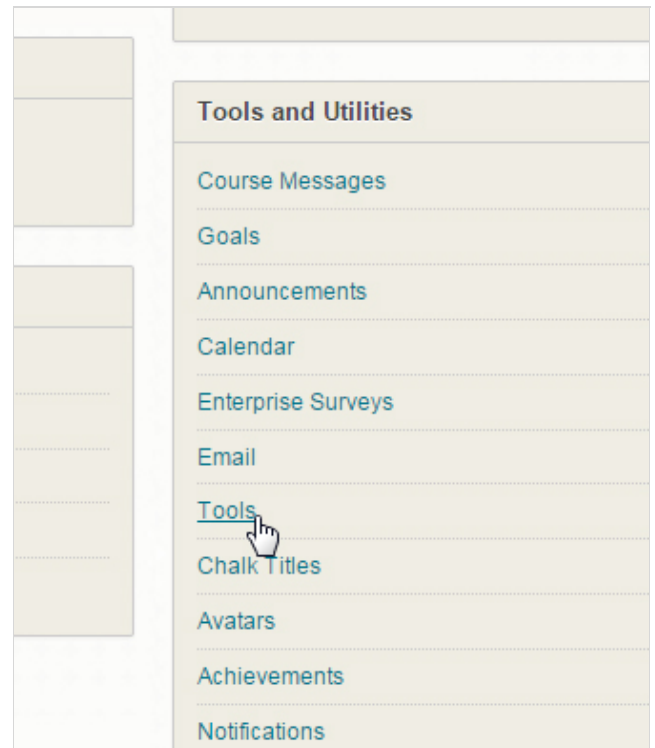
You will need to approve the changes to Building Blocks to continue.

If this is the first time you are installing the ClickView Plugin for Blackboard, you will need to change its availability for courses and organisations.

To do so, visit 'Tools' within the Administration Panel.

Find the ClickView Video Content Block section and turn its Availability to ON.

We also recommend you set the Scope of Change to 'New and existing courses and organizations'.

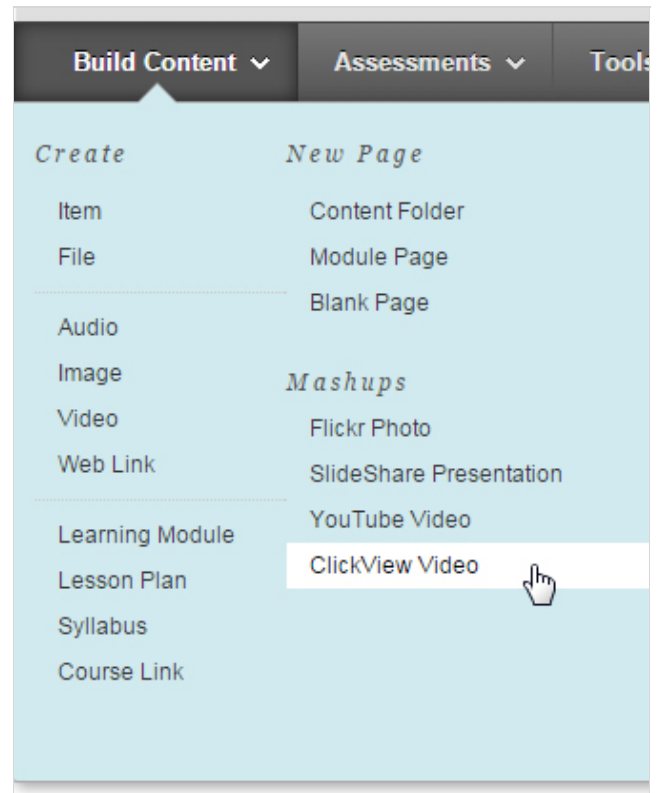
Remember to click the 'Submit' button when you're done!
