

Installing the ClickView Plugin for Firefly

The ClickView Plugin for Firefly enables you to quickly and safely browse through your entire ClickView library, the ClickView Exchange and your own personal Workspace from within Firefly, making it easy to embed educational videos directly into your pages and share them with your students.

1 To install the ClickView plugin for Firefly, first download it.

This plugin integrates with the Firefly Learning Platform and your existing Single Sign On system so that you can quickly browse through your entire ClickView library, the ClickView Exchange and your personal Workspace from within your VLE.

You can embed videos into your lesson plan with one click and use the fully featured ClickView Web Player to share educational videos with your students.

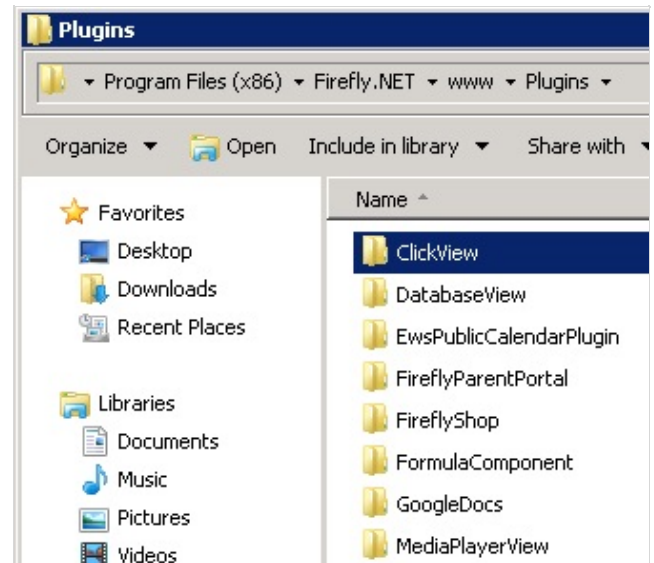

2 Extract the contents from the zipped plugin folder.

Copy the extracted contents into your Firefly Plugins folder.

On a default Firefly installation, this should be:
C:\Program Files (x86)\Firefly.NET\www\Plugins



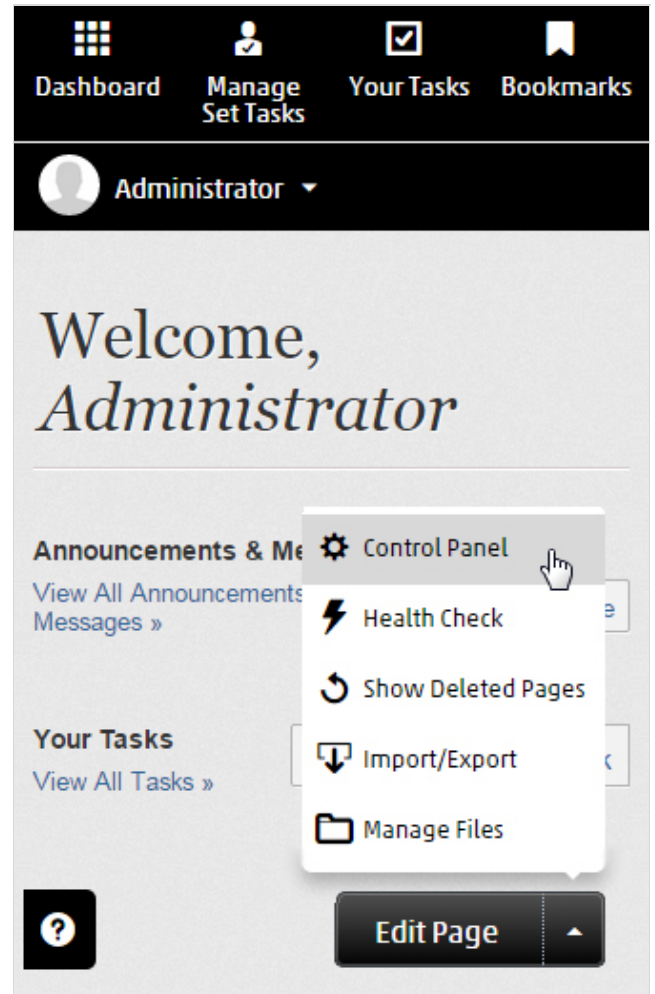

Log into Firefly with an Administrative account.


Select 'Control Panel' from the 'Edit Page' options.

Once the reload is complete, refresh your page.

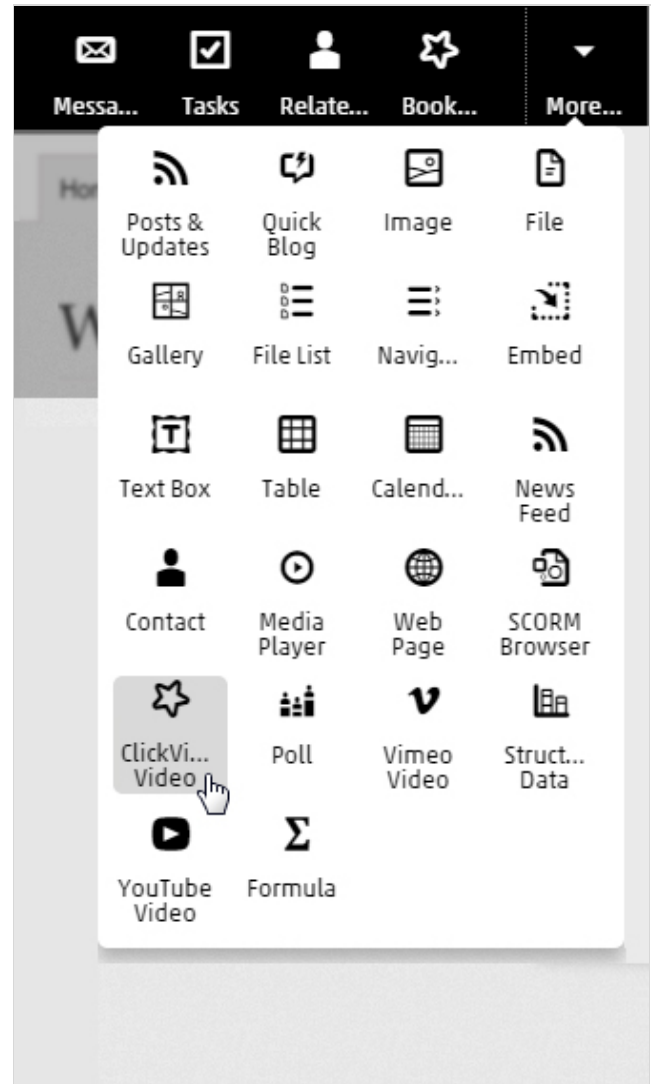
